#### **ST. JOHN'S – VILMAR COUNCIL CAPSULE** Special Session – Wednesday, Aug. 25, 2021

The St. John's Church council met for a special council meeting on Wednesday, Aug. 25, 2021 at 7 p.m., in the council room. Diane Hummel opened the meeting with devotions. Chairman, Ron Salge, called the meeting to order. The purpose of the council meeting was to discuss a possible part-time pastoral contract with Pastor David Craig. The council first discussed St. John's constitution and how it related to offering a contract for a part-time pastoral position. President Ron Salge read section 11.01g of the constitution, as it pertained to the council's responsibilities, "To arrange for pastoral service during the sickness or absence of the pastor," and that the council could continue with a contract without taking it to the congregation for a vote. Moving forward, the council had previously decided that information was needed from the church accountant before the council could vote on offering a contract. Brenda Boden shared the financial information she received concerning the reporting of housing allowance, taxes, and medical reimbursement. After much discussion, Don Salge made a motion to offer a one year, part-time pastoral contract, dated Oct. 1, 2021 – Sept. 30, 2022, to Pastor David Craig. Jeff Seehusen seconded the motion. A ballot vote was taken. The vote was 9 yes, 1 no, and 1 abstained from voting. Motion carried. The specifics of the contract were discussed and Monica will prepare a typed contract for council's final approval by Sunday, Aug. 29. Meeting adjourned with the Lord's Prayer. Council members present: Ron Salge, Barb Wagner, Brenda Boden, Diane Hummel, Julie Eberline, Jason Edeker, Evan Steere, Jeff Seehusen, Barb Meyer, Warren Van Dyke, Don Salge, and Tyler Seehusen. #### **CONTRACTED PART-TIME PASTORAL AGREEMENT**

St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church – Vilmar is offering the following, one-year contract to Rev. David Craig beginning Oct. 1, 2021 and ending Sept. 30, 2022, with the following obligations: (Adult Bible Class follows the Sunday School schedule and runs from the first Sunday after Labor Day and concludes the Sunday before Memorial Day.) The pastor will complete visitations one day per week\* [This will include: homebound, inactive, sick, and distressed. A list of the people visited and/or communed plus mileage from each week will need to be provided to the Director of Communications and Treasurer for record and reimbursement, respectively.] \*The day of the week may be determined by the pastor as fits his schedule. The pastor will complete hospital visitations one day per week, only as the need arises\*\* (This will only be hospitals within 60 miles of St. John's – Vilmar.) \*\*The day of the week may be determined by the pastor, or if he is available for an immediate emergency situation. [This includes: Ash Wednesday, 5 Mid-week Lenten Services, Maundy Thursday (with the stripping of the altar), Thanksgiving Eve, and Christmas Day – as they fall within the contracted timeframe.] Housing Allowance......\$400.00/month Funerals Funeral payments will be made by the funeral home. If the family doesn't use a funeral home, payment will come from the family. That will need to be settled between the pastor and the family at that time. Weddings The pastor will not be obligated to officiate weddings. Paid Time Off ......\$300/week The pastor will have an allowance of 6 weeks\*\*\* of paid time off (PTO) [It is the pastor's discretion as to how he chooses to use this time, (i.e.: vacation, sick leave, appointments, etc.), as it is all encompassed in the 6 weeks of PTO.] \*\*\*Both the visitation day and the Sunday worship service/class will constitute a "full week," and each week of PTO must be used in "full week" increments. Additional Salary.....\$3,000.00/year, per person Reimbursement for the patient's responsibility of medical bills incurred within the contract period. Limit of \$3,000.00/year for David Craig and \$3,000.00/year for Jacque Craig. Documentation must be provided. Notes • Mileage will be calculated and paid at the current IRS guidelines for mileage reimbursement rate. • Paychecks will be issued twice monthly, on the 15th and the last day of the month. • Housing Allowance will split between each bi-monthly paycheck. • The Vilmar parsonage will be available for use during the contracted time. No livestock is allowed in the home.

#### REPORTS

- **Secretary:** Barb Wagner gave the secretary's report. There were no corrections or additions and would stand approved as read.
- **Treasurer:** Brenda Boden gave the treasurers report. Thanks yous were read from Makayla Shear for the NB Scholarship and from Earl and Terri Hardisty. The current operating budget is \$61,125.60. The genera l fund balance is \$77,831.71. Go Serv Global was sent \$1,000 in August, for September missions.
- Chairman: No report.
- Stewardship & Finance: No report.
- Mission & Outreach: Mission Spotlight for September is GoServ Global. October will be Operation Christmas Child.
- Worship & Fellowship: The Williamson Gospel Group will present a morning of Gospel Music on Sept. 12. The council discussed the love offering that would be given to them. After some discussion Warren VanDyke made a motion to present \$1,000 to the group. Jeff Seehusen seconded the motion. Council approved. Any money in the collection made out to The Williamson's will be forwarded to them.
- Deacons: No report.
- Trustees: No report.
- Parish Ed.: Julie Eberline reported that Sunday School is ready to resume classes on Sept. 12. There are a possible 13 youth and 4 high school students. Bibles will be handed out during the Sept. 19 service. Sunday School Teacher Installation will be Sept. 26. Monica Edeker reported that due to the lack of volunteers, the committee doesn't have anyone available to teach the Little Lutherans program on Wednesday evenings. Unless the parents would like to lead the class or if anyone knows of someone else who would like to teach the committee is suspending the class on Wednesday evenings. Diane Hummel continues to work with Blake to finish his confirmation instruction, as classes were disrupted during COVID last school year. Monica and Jason Edeker will be in charge of the Luther League program.
- **Director of Communications:** Monica Edeker reported that the Mission District meeting will be held in Emmons, Minnesota, and Ken and Margaret DeBower will be St. John's representatives.

#### OLD BUSINESS

• Over the past months, Ron Salge has been working to find a company/business that would come to Vilmar to determine our sound system needs. The Iowa Falls company contacted Ron and regretted that they would be unable to come in a timely matter and would no longer be interested.
