Wednesday, Nov. 8, 2023

OPENING

Jen Seehusen gave a presentation to the council about Tithely Giving – an online giving option that can be added to our website or downloaded as an app on a smartphone/tablet for a digital avenue for donations to the church/Wells of Inspiration mission project. Margaret DeBower made a motion to set up a Tithely Giving account that deposits into a new, separate church bank account at Lincoln Savings Bank for these online donations. Dale Janssen seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

- **Secretary:** Diane Hummel made a motion to approve all the minutes as read. Dick Ulrich seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
- **Treasurer:** Warren Van Dyke made a motion to approve the report at read. Meredith Steere seconded. Motion carried unanimously.


