ST. JOHN'S – VILMAR COUNCIL CAPSULE

Wednesday, Nov. 10, 2021

The St. John's Church Council met for its regular meeting on Wednesday, Nov. 10, 2021 at 7 p.m. in the kitchen. Diane Hummel gave the opening devotion based on Psalm 27. Council chairman, Ron Salge called the meeting to order.

REPORTS

- **Secretary:** Secretary Barb Wagner gave the minutes from the October meeting. There were no corrections or additions and the minutes would stand approved as read.
- **Treasurer:** Brenda Boden gave the treasurer's report. The current operating balance is \$62,302.56 with \$75,630.01 in the general fund. There were no correction or additions to the treasurer's report and would stand approved as read.
- **Chairman:** Chairman's Report Ron Salge was contacted by Senior Choir Director, Jane Thompson, concerning the senior choir going Christmas carolling this year. The council discussed and decided that the individuals who would be carolled to should be contacted to see if they were comfortable with carolling visitors.
- Stewardship & Finance: No report.
- Mission & Outreach: No report.
- Worship & Fellowship: Pastor Marshall Hahn will lead the worship service on Sunday, Nov. 21. Pastor Hahn will be giving a presentation during the Sunday School hour on the mission project undertaken by our mission partner church body, the Ethiopian Evangelical Church Mekane Yesus. The project goal is the construction of a new building to provide space and funding for the training of Bible translators. Christmas Eve service will be at 6:30 p.m., and Christmas morning will begin at 9:15 a.m. The Christmas offering will go to three radio stations- Christian Crusaders, Life 101,9 and American Family 88.9.
- Deacons: No report.
- **Trustees:** Warren VanDyke reported that Ron Taylor did a beautiful job refinishing the podium in the narthex. The council thanks Ron for taking on this project. Wayne Dralle and Warren VanDyke removed the trees from the cemetery. Warren also donated a vacuum cleaner for use at the parsonage. A service call was done on the furnace and was in good condition, however parts for the furnace are no longer available. Don Olson from West Music took measurements for the new speakers. Installation will be in the near future.

- **Director of Communications:** Monica Edeker reported that the Women's Fellowship ordered 400 cookbooks of the first edition. They will ready for distribution soon. The cost per coobook is \$15. The Thanksgiving offering will be divided between the North Butler Lunch Program and Butler County Visions of Well Being. The focus for December missions will be the Gideons and a local family in need of helping during the Christmas holiday. Vilmar members are invited to attend a meal packing event for GoServ Global at Algona United Methodist Church on Sunday, Nov. 14 from 2:30-4:30 p.m.

EECMY Mission

On Sunday, Nov. 21 Rev. Marshall Hahn gave an interesting presentation on an exciting mission project undertaken by our mission partner church body, the Ethiopian Evangelical Church Mekane Yesus (EECMY). They are partnering with Lutheran Bible Translators (LBT) in the construction of a new building on the seminary in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. Their goal in this project is to provide space and funding for training Bible translators to spread the Gospel to the people of Ethiopia and Beyond.

Unfortunately the seminary and people in the area suffered from a devastating flood. Tragically eight members of the seminary community lost their lives while some students and faculty lost their homes.
