NALC News

'Assistants to the Bishop' appointed by Bishop Selbo

¬ ive area assistants to the bishop have been appointed by NALC **◄** Bishop Dan Selbo. The primary role of these new assistants to the bishop is to provide discipling and pastoral care for the deans, pastors and mission districts in five geographic areas of the North American Lutheran Church.

The new assistants to the bishop are the Rev. Dr. Jesse Abbott of Loveland, Ohio; the Rev. Mark Braaten of Bullard, Texas; the Rev. Marvin Combs of Huntington Beach, California, the Rev. Kevin Ree of Bentley, Alberta; and the Rev. William "Bill" White of Lexington, South Carolina.

The positions were created in response to an action of the 2021 NALC Mission Convocation. These part-time positions (10 hours per week) begin in May and will be responsible and accountable to the bishop.

The new positions are designed to be an extension and evidence of the denominational commitment to discipleship and a model of the kind of discipling relationships the NALC seeks to have among its pastors and congregational members throughout the NALC.

The five area assistants were chosen by Bishop Selbo from a list of nominees provided by mission districts. The selections were confirmed by the Executive Council at its January meeting. The pastors were installed in their new positions on Feb. 16 during worship at the NALC Pastors' Conference in Orlando, Florida.

Two of the five assistants will serve two-year terms, with the other three serving for three years. After the initial staggered terms, which are renewable, all future appointments will be for three years.

"As the NALC continues to grow numerically, it is essential that we stay connected and continue to grow in the support and discipling relationships we provide," said Bishop Selbo. "The connections offered through the area assistants will enhance the communication and support we offer to our pastors and deans, and strengthen our commitment to the Great Commission we have been given by our Lord Jesus."
