These lists are in no particular order.

Special Ministry Ideas

- Vilmar's 150th Anniversary (Nov. 29, 1879 Nov. 29, 2029)
 We are looking for volunteers to be a part of the 150th committee to plan events for our sesquicentennial year; example of ideas include: QR codes/map and a Cemetery Walk
- Contemporary Service Offering an additional worship service each month or week led by musicians with contemporary music and songs (not live-streamed - in person only)
- Noisy Offering Have the kids collect a 'noisy offering' each week during the church services
- Polka Service Host a special Polka Service (possibly at Wilder Park)
- Lutheran School (Homeschool-Based Campus) – Being a campus/ social setting for local homeschooled children to host classes and such
- Adult Sunday School Starting a Sunday School class (not necessarily on Sundays, due to confirmation conflict for Pastor as well as practice for the choir members)
- Little Lutherans (WINGS/Jr. Lutherans) – Wednesday afterschool Bible class for 4th, 5th, and 6th graders

Groups/Classes/Clubs

- Card-Making Club People can get together and make cards and/or send cards to our shut-ins, etc.
- Cooking Class Local chefs (and members) could share cooking tips and ideas with anyone who's interested
- Young People's Group A group designated for the younger people to get together and have Bible studies and/or outings
- **Jam Session** Random musicians get together and have a performance for the church
- Creative Arts Class Instructor led crafts classes
- Dartball League People learn to play dartball and possibly compete in the local leagues as we learn
- Walking Club People get together and walk the trails at Wilder Park on a regular basis
- **Book Club** People read books and meet for discussions/study
- Singles/Adult Group A group designated for the older people to get together and have Bible studies and/ or outings
- "The Chosen" Viewing A group that watches episodes of "The Chosen" together and then completes the Bible Study/Discussion about it

Outreach Ideas

- Card Sending Reaching out to old and possible new members about attending church or joining for events
- School Group Performances –
 Reaching out to schools or groups about have "practice performances" at our church
- Request Night (Talent/Gift Show)
 People can share their musical gifts through performances
- **Tree Planting** Setting up a community service tree planting in the local communities/parks
- Non-Talent Show Contact people to help learn new skills to share with the church
- NALC Church Visits (Vacation Sunday) — Work with other NALC churches to set up retreats, activities, or events together
- **Service Projects** Work in the local communities on service projects
- Feed the Farmers Meal Drive-up meal pick-up
- Farmer Sack Lunch Deliver sack meals to local co-ops to be given out to the farmers during harvest
- Parent's Night Out Parents can go out and do something as a group, and leave their kids are at the church for babysitting

- **Meal Fundraisers** People can bid on a meal for each month
- Potluck Assigned Seats A new way to get to know members
